## ATTENTION BSN AND ADN PREPARED NURSES ANNOUNCING THE SWIFT PROGRAM

The shortage of nursing faculty within the State of Wisconsin is reaching a critical point. The University of Wisconsin System has received a grant from the Department of Labor to address this critical need. The grant will expand the number of Master's prepared nurses for faculty positions.

Children's Hospital of Wisconsin is participating in the grant and will support up to three staff for the program. The program allows a staff member to obtain a Master's degree in Nursing in exchange for a three year part-time teaching commitment upon graduation. Children's Hospital will support staff with 16 hours of education time per pay period for course work (when school is in session), in addition to \$5000 of tuition assistance.

Eligibility for consideration for program is as follows:

Full time Employment Status (.9 – 1.0 FTE)  
ADN, BSN prepared nurses, nurses enrolled in master's program interested in transferring are eligible as well.

Staff member must not be in active disciplinary process (if staff member enters disciplinary process during the course of study, Children's Hospital of Wisconsin reserves the right to discontinue support in the program).

If you are interested in this program you will need to have taken a Statistics course within the last five years. The Statistics course must be a senior level undergraduate statistics course.

The program is set to start September 2007. Admission deadline is March 1, 2007
